Ingwe is situated on a farm within an indigenous forest in The Crags, just 15 minutes from Plettenberg Bay.

Our aim is to minimise our mark on the environment and apart from offering facilitated programmes and outdoor activities aimed at team building, leadership and environmental education, we are the ideal venue for family getaways and outdoor adventurers looking for a base in our beautiful area. We are situated nearby many popular outdoor activities and attractions in the area that can be included in your stay. Ingwe is also an ideal venue for Events and Weddings offering both the accommodation and accommodation for your guests.

Accommodation

SELF-CATERING CABINS

Forest Cottage: Sleeps 14 people in 7 bedrooms, with an open plan lounge, dining area and kitchen, 2 bathrooms with showers. A private weber braai area and two wooden decks to choose from to soak up the sounds of the forest. Bedding is provided but please bring your own toiletries and towels.

Rates are from R250 pppn Minimum of 8 pax or value thereof required per night



Tree House cabin:

Most beautiful views from this cabin, that has 2 bedrooms, both en-suite with showers and sleeps a total of 6 people. Main room has twin beds and the other room has 2 bunk beds that can be separated. Lovely lounge with fireplace and fully equipped kitchen. Stunning views from lounge and wooden deck area with private garden and braai area. Ideal cabin for families.

Rates are from R300 pppn Minimum of 4 pax or value thereof required per night



Olive Tree Cottage:

A fully equipped charming cottage for two privately situated with a deck overlooking the forested valleys.

Rate per night is R800 for 2 people. Min 2 night stay, single rate is R600 per night



DORMITORY CABINS

Honeybadger & Bushbuck:

Two dormitory cabins with big chunky bunk beds sleep 26 in each. The two bedrooms sleep 8 people in each, with extra beds in the front entrance room. Wooden decks overlook the forest and rolling valleys. Sheets are provided, bring your own other bedding, towels and toiletries.

Self-catering facilities, fully equipped kitchen and boma area are situated in the main lodge nearby.

These cabins make use of an ablution block with showers.

Rates are from R180 pppn Minimum of 8 pax or value thereof required per night



Exclusivity:

At a nominal fee we can offer your group private and exclusive use of Ingwe's accommodation and/or facilities.

Rates start at R8 400 per night for up to 40 people, thereafter a pppn is applicable



Activities and Facilitated Programmes at Ingwe

Facilitation is on a 1:10 ratio with a minimum group of 16 people. Duration is at least ½ a day unless otherwise stated.
